Subject: Clarification regarding charging of extension fee for residential and commercial property.

In continuation to the instructions issued vide No.PUDA-P&C-98/185-94 dated 15.1.98, it is clarified that the rates of extension fee have been revised and made applicable w.e.f. 1.1.98. However, where the allottee has already paid the extension fee upto 30.6.98 as per our instructions dated 18.2.97 and has completed the building upto 30.6.98, no extension fee beyond the period 30.6.98 be charged and where we have already given extension upto 30.6.98 in view of the instructions dated 18.2.97 and construction has not been completed, extension fee may be charged from 1.1.98 at the revised rates and the fee already deposited may be adjusted towards the year 1998.

Further, provisions made under rule (4) of the Punjab Regional and Town Planning and Development ( General ) Rules, 1995, are modified as under:-

Extension for full seven calendar years i.e. from 1st January to 31st December may be granted and the year of extension may be treated from 1st January after the moratorium period of three years is over. However, for the intervening period between the date of allotment and 30th November after the last moratorium year, we may charge the extension fee @ 2% of the prevailing price on proportionate basis required before 31st December after the last moratorium year. For example, if the date of allotment is January, 1995, three years period will expire in December, 1998 and extension shall be granted for full calendar year by charging the prescribed rate per annum.


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In case of subsequent months, the moratorium period shall stand extended upto 31st December, but on a payment of the fee at prescribed rate proportionately for subsequent months. The formal extension period of seven years shall commence from 1st January in subsequent calendar year. However, in case of allotments made in December, the regular extension period shall commence from 1st January of the subsequent year and there will be no extension in the moratorium period. For example, the following schedule shall apply for the allotments made in the year 1995:-

March, 95	3 years 10 months	1st January, 1999;

June, 95	3 years 7 months	1st January, 1999;
July, 95	3 years 6 months	1st January, 1999;
August, 95	3 years 5 months	1st January, 1999;

October, 95	3 years 3 months	1st January, 1999;
November, 95	3 years 2 months	1st January, 1999;
December, 95	3 years 1 months ( without any ext. fee for moratorium period)	1st January, 1999;

ii) It is further clarified that the extension fee at the prevailing rate fixed by PUUDA may be charged. The foot-note given in the annexure A-I and A-II stands deleted.

iii) In case the rates of extension fee are mentioned in the allotment letter issued earlier ( As has been done in one of the schemes at Patiala), the extension fee at the present revised rates shall be charged.
